BOUNCING RABBIT:

MATERIALS:

- 1. 2 lengths of 50mm white stripping, each length is 80cm.
- 2. 4 lengths of 25mm white stripping, each length is 40cm.
- 3. One sheet square white cardboard
- 4. One white pom pom
- 5. Two joggle eyes
- 6. Template of the rabbit head, teeth, and inner ears
- 7. Glue, Scissors, Markers, Paints.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Body: Fold the two lengths of 50mm stripping into a DOUBLE FAN FOLD. Refer to the illustration below.
- 2. Legs: Fold each length of 25mm stripping into a single fan fold.
- 3. Cut the rabbit head shape from white cardboard
- 4. Cut inner ear shapes and the teeth from the stripping
- 5. Cut thin strips from the stripping for whiskers and colour black with a marker
- 6. Glue on joggle eyes, inner ears, teeth, pom pom (nose), whiskers to the rabbit head
- 7. Glue head, body, and legs together
- 8. Decorate the head with markers or paints

OPTIONAL IDEAS:

- Glue a string on to the back of the head to hang the rabbit up.
- Use felt or foam to make inner ears and teeth
- Use coloured stripping and cardboard to make body, legs, and head

DOULBE FAN FOLD:

Fold A over B then B back over A
