BUNNY IN A BOX:

MATERIALS:

- 1. 2 lengths of 25mm white stripping, each length is 25cm.
- 2. One sheet square white cardboard
- 3. Two joggle eyes
- 4. Easter bunny stickers
- 5. Template of box and bunny head
- 6. Glue, Scissors, Markers, Paints.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Cut the box shape from the white cardboard, fold and glue to make a box, leave the lid open.
- 2. Fold the two lengths of 25mm stripping into a DOUBLE FAN FOLD. Refer to the illustration below.
- 3. Cut the bunny head shape from white cardboard
- 4. Glue the folded stripping onto the bottom of the box
- 5. Glue the bunny head onto the top of the folded stripping
- 6. Glue joggle eyes onto bunny head
- 7. Decorate the head with markers
- 8. Decorate the box with bunny stickers, paints, markers, or glitters
- After glue and paint are dry, push down the stripping so the bunny head hides in the box. Close the lid. Play with opening the lid, the bunny head will bounce out of the fox.

OPTIONAL IDEAS:

- Use felt or foam to make inner ears, nose and teeth
- Use coloured cardboard to make box and bunny head

DOULBE FAN FOLD:

Fold A over B then B back over A
