

WOOLLY SHEEPS

Materials Supplied in the Kit:

- PRINTED CARD SHEEP SHAPES
- COTTON TWINE WHITE
- COTTON WOOL BALLS
- STICKERS

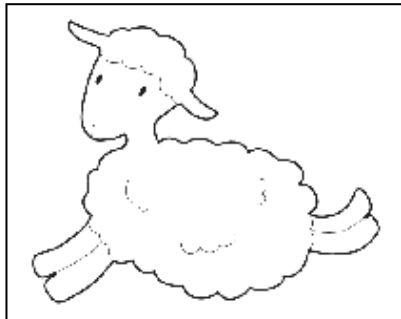


Materials and Tools Needed but not supplied in the Kit:

- Black marker
- Black, orange, pink and yellow pastel
- PVA Glue
- Scissors

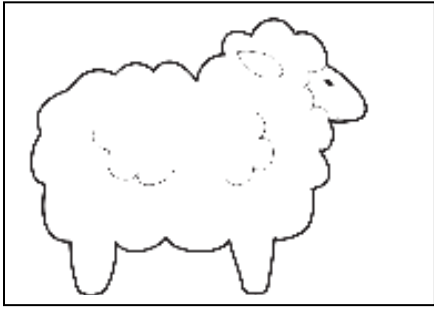
This kit includes 3 sheep cut-outs: Running Sheep, Standing Sheep and Sheep character.

Procedure of Running Sheep:



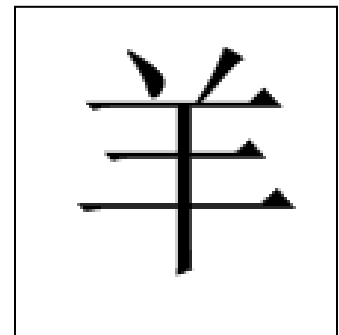
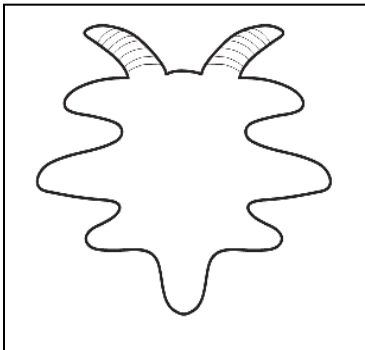
1. Colour the face, ears and legs with orange, pink or yellow pastel. Choose the colour you like.
2. Tear the cotton wool balls. Make smaller, loose cotton wool balls. Use PVA to glue the cotton wool onto the body of the sheep, and the forehead as well. Cover the body and forehead with cotton wool balls.
3. Leave till the PVA dries. Then you'll have a lovely woolly running sheep.

Procedure of Standing Sheep:



1. Cut 10cm, 20cm and 30cm lengths of cotton string from the cotton twine. Coil up the string. Different length of string makes different size of coil.
2. Glue the coil onto the body of the sheep with PVA. Make sure the coil is tight, then glue onto sheep. Then make another coil, and glue on. Keep doing this until the sheep body is covered with cotton string coils.
3. After PVA dries, colour the face and legs with black pastel, or other colour of pastels as you like. Smudge the pastel.
4. Another woolly sheep is done!

Procedure of Sheep Character:



This shape is an imitation of Chinese character of sheep: 羊. Colour it with pastel, crayon, coloured pencils or paint. Draw eyes, ears and feet with black marker. Decorate with stickers.

Or, simply trace in the centre of the shape to learn this Chinese word: 羊 (sheep, pronouncing “yang”)

Now you’ve made three different shapes of sheep to celebrate the Chinese Year of Sheep: 2015.
