POLY BALL BUNNY

Materials Supplied in the Kit:

POLYSTYRENE BALL 75MM
POLYSTYRENE BALL 100MM
CHENILLE STEMS PINK/YEL/WHT
GLITTER POM POM RED 10MM
GLITTER POM POM WHITE 25MM
JOGGLE EYES - GLUE ON 8mm
FOAM SHEETS WHITE
BAMBOO SKEWER



Materials and Tools Needed but not supplied in the Kit:

BLACK MARKER

Paint: Pink or Yellow

GLUE

SCISSORS

Procedure:

- 1. Cut the bamboo skewer in half. Use one half of the bamboo skewer to poke a hole on each of the two poly balls: one 75mm ball and the other 100mm ball. Then connect the two balls with the bamboo skewer.
- 2. Use the other half of the bamboo skewer to poke two holes on the top of the 75mm poly ball, for the positions of the ears. And poke two holes at the bottom of the 100mm poly ball, for the positions of the feet. The holes don't need to be very deep. Approx. 1cm into the poly ball.
- 3. Leave the second half of the bamboo skewer in one of the holes. Hold onto the bamboo skewer for stabilization when painting the two poly balls with pink or yellow paint. Or, if you'd like a white bunny, just leave it without painting.
- 4. Get four chenille stems of one colour, matching the colour of the poly balls. Cut the chenille stems into 22cm lengths. Each stem makes an oval loop, for the shape of ear or foot and tie up the ends.
- 5. When the paint on the poly balls dries, insert the tied ends of the four chenille stem loops into the four holes on the two poly balls, to make two ears and two feet.
- 6. Use a black marker to outline the mouth and whiskers on the small poly ball.
- 7. Glue two Joggle eyes, a red 10mm glitter pom pom and a white 25mm glitter pom pom onto the positions of eyes, nose and tail.
- 8. Cut a 12mm x 12mm square from the white foam sheet. Cut midway into the square. Glue the foam square under the red glitter pom pom nose.
- 9. A cute bunny is now done!
